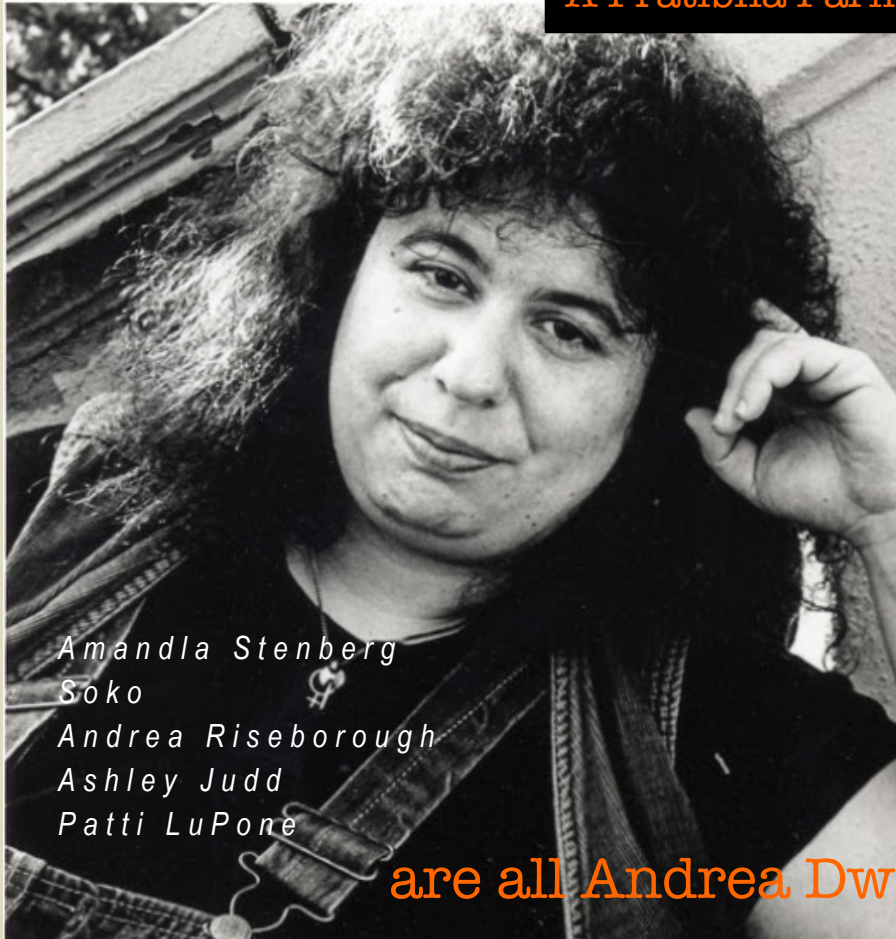

A cinematic evocation of key moments from the life of feminist outlaw, maverick thinker, and intellectual genius of the 20th Century Andrea Dworkin. Dworkin's powerful voice speaks vividly to our contemporary #MeToo moment and reveals the lasting influence of a controversial, global feminist thinker.

My Name Is Andrea is a hybrid feature documentary about one of the most radical and controversial writers of the 20th Century Andrea Dworkin, who offered a revolutionary analysis of male supremacy with a singular, apocalyptic urgency. Dworkin used her personal experiences of sexual assault to develop epic concepts around what it means to be a woman. Electrifying, rare archival footage of Dworkin is interwoven with expressionistic dramatizations performed by Amandla Stenberg, Soko, Andrea Riseborough, Ashley Judd and Patti LuPone. Dworkin's voice drives the narrative arc with a powerful subjective narration in a similar style to *I Am Not Your Negro*. *My Name Is Andrea* shows how Dworkin was driven by an absolute conviction that women must be freed from their inferiority and that freedom can only come from a fundamental reinvention of what we mean by human. Dworkin asked, "...what are the manifestations and consequences of gender and sexual inequality and its impact on women. How do we begin to create paradigm shifts in culture that treat women as less than human?" Dubbed the Malcolm X of the women's movement Dworkin was a revolutionary thinker who created whole new understandings and shredded old ones with her words. Dworkin's rallying cry for equality remains urgent and prescient for our current high stakes times.
